Unfortunately, members of our community are not respecting the closures of our Playgrounds, Fields, Courts and Disc Golf Course. In an effort to keep our open space available to the public and keep our residents safe, we are limiting access to our parks via vehicle where possible, locking all access points possible to fields and courts, wrapping playgrounds with caution tape and have asked both Will County Police and the Manhattan Police Department to patrol our parks.

We do not want to close our parks completely and ask everyone to respect the seriousness of the COVID-19 situation and abide by these closures appropriately. Please monitor your children in the parks and ensure their safety by following these guidelines.

The Manhattan Park District's number one priority is the safety and health of our participants, staff and community.
