





#### REGISTRATION

Registration for Fall 2022 Programs opens on <u>August 8, 2022</u>. Registration can be completed online at www.manhattanparks.org or by phone at 815.478.3324. All registrations must be completed **at least 7 days in advance** of the start date of a program, except where noted otherwise in the program description. Those with outstanding balances must settle their account before future registration will be processed.

#### **REFUND POLICY**

Refunds will not be issued after the program deadline date (7 days before the start of a program unless otherwise noted). At the discretion of the Park District, a refund may be issued if a refund request is accompanied by documentation from a physician. A refund will be promptly issued for programs canceled by the Park District. Refunds will not be issued for programs that transition from inperson to virtual due to changing government guidelines.

#### CANCELATIONS

The Park District does everything in its power to run programs and minimize cancelations. Occasionally a program must be canceled if it does not meet the required minimum number of participants or due to other unforeseen emergencies or circumstances. In the event of a cancelation, we will contact all registered participants and will attempt to reschedule any canceled program. If the program is unable to be rescheduled, we will offer transfer options or refunds.
