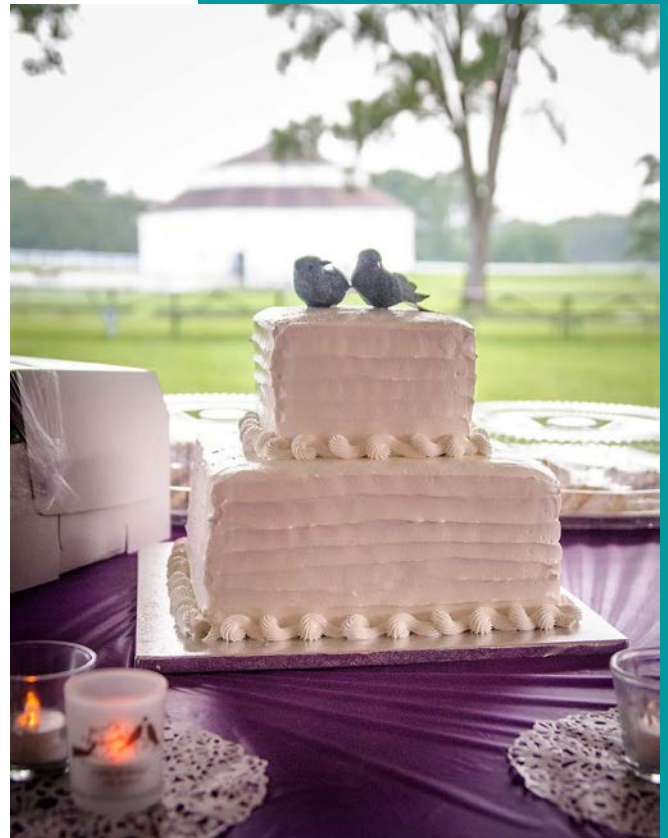

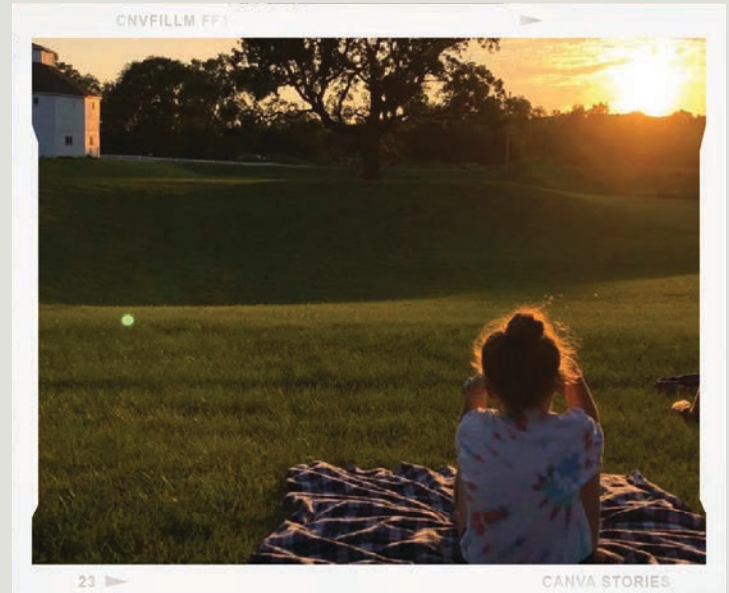

REGISTRATION

Registration for Spring and Summer 2021 Programs opens on March 1, 2021. Registration can be completed online at www.manhattanparks.org or by phone at 815.478.3324. All registrations must be completed **at least 7 days in advance** of the start date of a program, except where noted otherwise in the program description. Those with outstanding balances must settle their account before future registration will be processed.

REFUND POLICY

Refunds will not be issued after the program deadline date (7 days before the start of a program unless otherwise noted). At the discretion of the Park District, a refund may be issued if a refund request is accompanied by documentation from a physician. A refund will be promptly issued for programs canceled by the Park District. Refunds will not be issued for programs that transition from in-person to virtual due to COVID-19 guidance.

CANCELATIONS

The Park District does everything in its power to run programs and minimize cancellations. Occasionally a program must be canceled if it does not meet the required minimum number of participants or due to other unforeseen emergencies or circumstances. In the event of a cancellation, we will contact all registered participants and will attempt to reschedule any canceled program. If the program is unable to be rescheduled, we will offer transfer options or refunds.
