

Registration for Winter 2023 Programs opens on **December 5**. Registration can be completed online at www.manhattanparks.org, in person at the Hansen Community Center, or by phone at 815.478.3324. All registrations must be completed at least 7 days in advance of the start date of a program, except where noted otherwise in the program description. Those with outstanding balances must settle their account before future registration will be processed.

REFUND POLICY

Refunds will not be issued after the program deadline date (7 days before the start of a program unless otherwise noted). At the discretion of the Park District, a refund may be issued if a refund request is accompanied by documentation from a physician. A refund will be promptly issued for programs canceled by the Park District. Refunds will not be issued for programs that transition from inperson to virtual due to changing government guidelines.

CANCELATIONS

The Park District does everything in its power to run programs and minimize cancelations. Occasionally a program must be canceled if it does not meet the required minimum number of participants or due to other unforeseen emergencies or circumstances.
